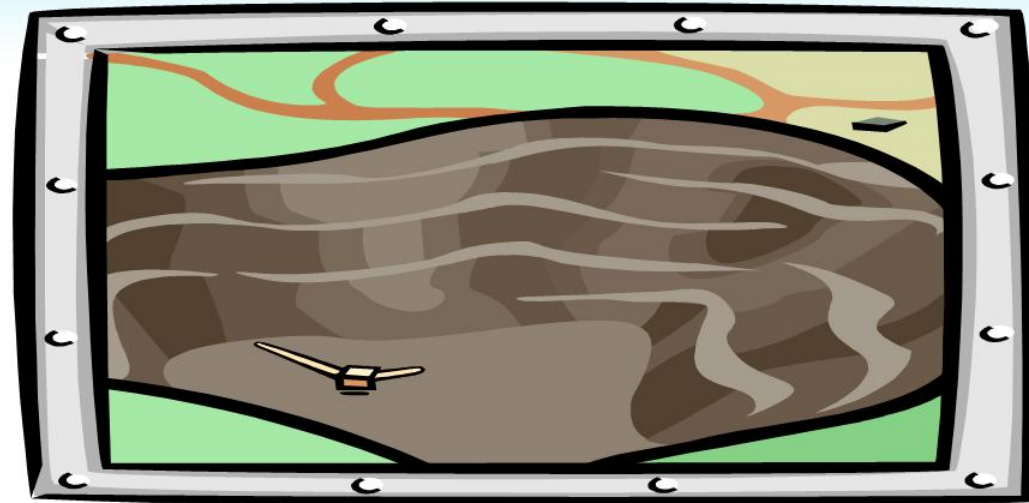

- Brief history of APP
- APP Objectives
  - Avoid litigation
  - Provide certainty
  - Avoid conflict
  - Secure long-term stable aggregate supply
  - Identify areas of prohibition vs “open season”

- Establish APP Mapping Designations - **Green Red Yellow Community Use Areas**
  - What do the colours mean?
- Implementation Measures
  - Soil Removal Bylaw (with fees and prohibitions)
  - MOU
  - Re-engagement of Industry

## Super Fee

- Province looking at province-wide “super fee”
  - \$0.90 local gov’t
  - \$0.25 Province
  - \$0.10 APABC

\$1.25 / tonne or m<sup>3</sup> (?)
- Local gov’t could use fee for variety of purposes
- Super fee is under review by Province
